

LOGIN VS. LOG IN

When do you use **login** (one word) and when do you use **log in** (two words)?

LOGIN

Login -- written as one word -- is used as a noun or adjective. For example, your website has a login page or your app counts the number of logins.

Log in -- written as two words -- is always used as a verb. For example, to access your account, you must first log in.

LOG IN

You don't **runin** to the store.



You don't **divein** to a pool.

You don't **login** to an account or app!
